Transmission via surfaces	Virus left on surfaces of equipment	M	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Inform public that equipment is not being routinely cleaned</li> <li>• Advise to use own wipes to clean points of contact before use</li> <li>• Advise to bring hand sanitiser and clean hands before and after using equipment</li> <li>• Advise not to consume food or drink in playground</li> <li>Advise to limit time in playground if it is busy</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Place risk assessment on website</li> <li>• Facebook post with key points</li> <li>• Signage on site to remind users of safety measures</li> </ul>
