

List of categories where S106 fund can be used.

- a) **Indoor community facilities** – currently the Village Hall. S106 funds can be used for such items as improved parking, improved footpaths, disabled access, new kitchen, new toilets, new storage, lighting and sound equipment, new meeting equipment (table/chairs etc.), soundproofing, new flooring, energy efficiency measures (where savings are in the form of reduced hiring charges) or decoration.

- b) **Outdoor community facilities** – The acquisition of land or facilities, the laying out and construction of land including sport pitches, facilities and equipment for play and / or sport and informal open space and the improvement or upgrading of land including sports pitches, facilities and / or equipment for play or sport and informal open space. Specific items that can be funded include: new grass pitches; artificial turf pitches, MUGAs, court and greens and ancillary facilities; Teenager play facilities such as ball courts and facilities for wheeled sports; Improvements to pavilions/changing facilities where they are unable to meet demand, are of a poor standard, or do not meet safety standards; Car / cycle parking and access routes where no satisfactory alternative provision exists and they are necessary to meet adopted highway safety and/or parking standards for the facilities and avoid any unacceptable impacts on nearby residents and businesses; Seating, lighting, play equipment, and other similar facilities that enable the safe, practical and reasonable use of the open space they serve; Improvements to the landscaping, planting or layout of spaces to improve the quality and amenity of open spaces; Improvements to pitch quality including ground and surface drainage, fencing or safety surfacing necessary to enable the facility to meet any relevant adopted standards and at an acceptable level and frequency of use.
