

Foxton Parish Council Policy on Developer involvement on Planning applications

Foxton Parish Council adopts as Council Policy, that when approached by developers for a meeting with the Parish Council prior to or after submission of a planning application, this Council shall, where practicable, agree to such a planning meeting (to be held in public) in line with advice from SCDC officers **only** when a planning application has been officially lodged and notified to the Parish Council by SCDC Planning Department.

Notification of such a meeting will be posted on the Parish Council website and Facebook page so that members of the public have the opportunity to attend.

This policy will be implemented where the application is for a residential development for more than four dwellings or any major planning application. The Council shall invite SCDC planning officers to be present both to advise and to witness the discussion.
